### PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES / ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

1. Ability to work with students who may suffer from acute or catastrophic illness or injury
2. Ability to provide learning experiences in a variety of settings.
3. Knowledge of child development
4. Broad knowledge of curriculum/instruction
5. Knowledge of current educational research
6. Knowledge of learning styles and skill in using varied teaching methods to address student learning styles
7. Skill in oral and written communication with students, parents, and others
8. Ability to implement instructional activities for maximum effectiveness
9. Ability to maintain appropriate student supervision so that students have a safe and orderly environment in which to learn
10. Ability to work effectively with peers, parents, administrators and others
11. Ability to maintain confidentiality
12. Utilize Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) as outlined at the school/district
13. Maintains regular and predictable attendance
14. Adheres to the professional code of ethics
15. Successfully utilizes technology as appropriate in job function
16. Maintain accurate, complete, and correct records as required by law, district policy, and administrative regulations

### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

1. Kentucky certificate, license, or other legal credential required
2. Experience and such alternatives to the above qualifications as the Superintendent may find appropriate and acceptable
