
#### Abstract

All students who drive to school must obtain a parking permit. Permits may be purchased in the office for $\$ 15$. Driving to school is a privilege and a responsibility extenaed to our students. Violations of the parking rules and regulations will result in the loss of a student's driving privilege.


## A. Rules and Regulations:

1. Speed limit 15 MPH .
2. Students must park in the student parking lot.
3. Parking tag must be displayed with the permit number visible from the front of the vehicle at all times.
4. No sitting in cars or loitering in the parking lot before, during or after school. Vehicles should exit the parking lot and school grounds immediately.
5. No driving to Vocational School without proper permission from both schools at least one day in advance.
(No riders allowed.)
6. Students must park in marked parking slots only. .
7. Students must enter and exit the school grounds in a careful and proper manner.
a. No fast starts, improper take-offs or spinning of wheels.
b. No cutting across parking lot. Drive in designated lanes.
c. No passing or cut-ins allowed.
d. No loud stereo or exhaust systems.
e. No unnecessary sounding of horns.
8. Students are not to leave litter of any kind on the parking lot.
9. Drivers will not haul passengers or riders in the back of pickup trucks or on the outside of any vehicle on school grounds. Once a vehicle has been started, all passengers must remain in the vehicle and refrain from interaction with students in other vehicles.
10. Drivers are responsible for the behavior of their passengers and riders.
11. Truancy, tardiness, and disciplinary problems may result in the loss of the students' driving privilege.
12. No drugs, alcohol or tobacco allowed in vehicles on the school grounds.
13. No weapons of any kind allowed.
14. These rules apply anytime the vehicle is on the school grounds.
15. Students will not be allowed to go to the parking lot during school hours.
16. All driver are subject to random drug testing. (Board Policy 09.423)

## B. Consequences for Violation:

Violation will result in loss of driving privileges. First Offense: Loss of driving privileges for 1 week. Second Offense: Loss of driving privileges for 6 weeks. Third Offense: Loss of driving privileges for 1 trimester.

Flagrant first time offenders may lose driving privilege. Drug, alcohol, and weapons offenders will be recommended for expulsion.
