Purpose: To dress in an acceptable and appropriate way that promotes learning and success in a safe and judge free environment.

In addition to the minimum standards for dress listed in the Hopkins County Schools Code of Conduct for Middle Schools, the following standards will be enforced at Browning Springs.

<u>SHIRTS</u>	
<u>Acceptable</u>	<u>Unacceptable</u>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Polos• Short Sleeve Shirts• Long Sleeve Shirts• Hoodies• ¾ Sleeve Shirts• Crewneck Sweatshirts• ¼ zip Sweatshirts - with appropriate undershirt• Light jackets (ex. North Face)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sleeveless• No holes (cold shoulder or off shoulder)• Winter coats are not allowed in classroom during school day (must be in locker)• No midriff or cleavage at any time should be seen.• Straps of undergarments (ex. bra) should not be visible
<u>PANTS</u>	
<u>Acceptable</u>	<u>Unacceptable</u>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Jeans• Khakis• Joggers• Shorts, dresses, skirts, and skorts must come to 2" above the knee• Leggings - paired with a top or dress that extends to the mid-thigh• All pants must be worn at waist	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• No holes, rips, frays at all• Sagging• Pajamas• No undergarments should be visible at any time. Anything worn underneath pants are considered an undergarment.
<u>SHOES</u>	
<u>Acceptable</u>	<u>Unacceptable</u>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Boots• Sandals• Athletic shoes• Appropriate for indoor and outdoor activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• House shoes• Shoes with wheels
<p>Shoes are required and must be safe and appropriate for indoor and outdoor activity. House-shoes and shoes with wheels are examples of inappropriate footwear for school and therefore are not allowed.</p>

ACCESSORIES, JEWELRY, HAIR COLOR, ETC.

Acceptable

- Normal ear piercings (small hoops and studs)
- Facial piercings (no hoops, studs only)
- Small purses/cross-body bags

Unacceptable

- Oversized hoops, gauges, spikes
- No blankets
- Backpacks in classrooms (must be kept in lockers)
- Book bags/purses/satchels (if it can fit a textbook, it is too large)

Spirit Weeks

On designated spirit days, alternate dress code will be acceptable for those specific days. (pajama day, hat day, Halloween, etc).
