
Beneath the appropriate term, select the first core subject area (in this example: Reading).

Beneath the Instruction module, select GRADING BY TASK.






Pick the first task. (HINT: The task you will grade for the Progress Report will always be the first one that shows up for the subject area when you go to GRADING BY TASK.)



For the task, choose OL (On Level) for the score, and click the FILL ALL button. All students will receive ON GRADE LEVEL.




Now find the students who are working either ABOVE LEVEL or BELOW LEVEL, and individually change their score appropriately.
