Behavior Expectations:

Grading:

Assignments will consist of:

Little, if any homework will be assigned. Students will have class time to finish assignments. If a student utilizes class time efficiently, there should be no need to complete assignments outside of the regularly scheduled class period. If an

absence occurs, that may necessitate completion of an assignment outside of the regular classroom period.

If assignments are completed and there is extra class time available, the expectation is that a student will be responsible about time management and read- a novel, nonfiction book or magazine depending on what we are working on.
