- identification for the school's Primary Talent Pool or Gifted and Talented services
- score at the 90th%ile or higher on a Standardized Achievement Test Total Battery;

Students may qualify with a recommendation from a teacher, counselor, or principal stating that the student demonstrates high potential, is motivated to learn, can focus energy working toward task completion AND is able to work cooperatively in a group setting with challenging content.

Where is drop-off and pick-up?

Drop your student off at the Brown Badgett, Sr. Energy and Advanced Technology Building (far right as you drive on to campus) on the campus of MCC. Walk your student in on the first day, then we have an organized pick-up line where vehicles line up with proper identification.
