The following criteria should be considered when making nominations:

Criteria for Athletes

- Player must have graduated from HCCHS five (5) years prior to induction
- Graduate in good standing with at least two (2) years participation in athletics at HCCHS
- Attained excellence as a player in high school and/or on the collegiate, amateur, or professional level
- Maintained good character and positive role model while participating in athletics

Criteria for Coaches

- Not active in the sport for which he/she is being inducted
- Achieved distinguished honors in the sport coached
- Made a lasting impact on Central Athletics

Criteria for Honorary Members

- Made a significant contribution to Central Athletics
- Impacted the history of athletics in Hopkins County
